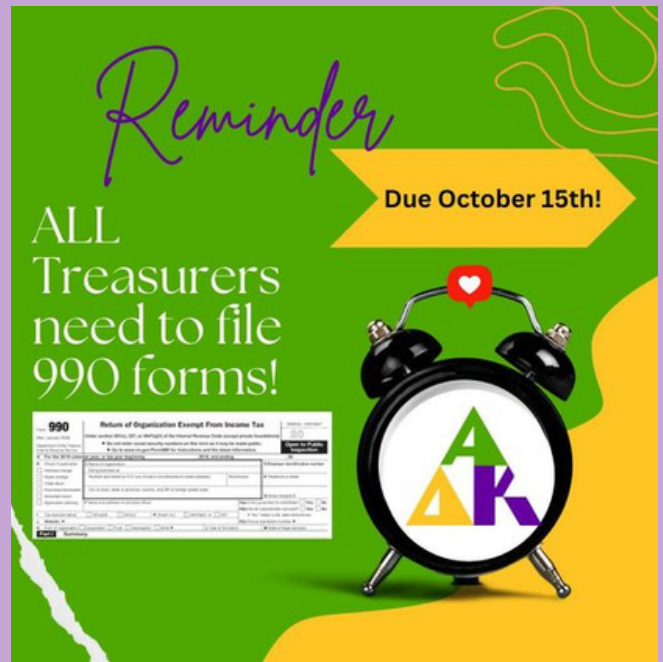

Excellence in Education

ADK is a sisterhood that recognizes excellence in education.

The Excellence in Education Award is designed to recognize members who are active educators (currently employed) for their outstanding contributions to education. This award is our highest honor, and it increases visibility and promotes ADK on the S/P/N, regional and international levels. The S/P/N level recipients are awarded \$500 and an EiE pin. The regional recipients are awarded \$1000 and an EiE engraved award. The International recipient is awarded \$5000 and an EiE engraved award. A nomination narrative is required and includes why the person is a worthy candidate for this award including a statement regarding the relationship to the nominee. I encourage ALL active educators to apply. Information pertaining to the EiE award can be located on the International website under Membership > Awards & Recognitions > Excellence in Education Award. The application with nomination is now open. The deadline for application is November 1st.
