How to determine Chapter Delegates:

Delegates to the State Convention are each State Executive Board Member, each District Chairman, State Committee Chairman, and each Chapter President or her alternate. Each chapter is allowed one (1) delegate for every ten (10) members.

Example: 24 members - 2 delegates

25 members - 3 delegates

If a chapter member is on the State Executive Board Member, District Chairman, State Committee Chairman, or Chapter President, **Do not count** them as one of your assigned chapter delegates.

Example: LA Alpha Chapter has State Treasurer Agnes, Chapter President Marion, and a total of 27 members. They would have five (5) voting delegates - Agnes, Marion, and three chapter members.

State and Chapter Archives:

Each Chapter and Past State President is asked to bring their archives to share with other sisters. I love to see our past adventures!

How to determine State Convention Chapter Delegates Worksheet

Each LA chapter is allowed one (1) delegate for every ten (10) members. Example: 24 members - 2 delegates 25 members - 3 delegates My LA chapter has _____ members. (number of chapter members) divided by 10 = . If the number is 0.5 or above, round up. This number is your chapter delegate number. Example: LA Alpha has 27 members. 27 members divided by 10 = 2.7. LA Alpha chapter would round up to three (3) delegates. **Do not count the Chapter President / President alternate in your delegate number above or the following positions: International Board member, Past State President, District Chairman, and State Committee Chairman. Example: The LA Alpha Chapter has a total of 27 members. (3) State Treasurer Agnes, Chapter President Marion, and Past State President Marie, They would have six (6) voting delegates - Agnes, Marion, Marie, and three chapter members.
