## How to determine State Convention Chapter Delegates Worksheet

Each LA chapter is allowed one (1) delegate for every ten (10) members.
Example: 24 members - 2 delegates
25 members - 3 delegates
My LA chapter has $\qquad$ members.
(number of chapter members) $\qquad$ divided by $10=$ $\qquad$ .
If the number is 0.5 or above, round up. $\qquad$
This number is your chapter delegate number. $\qquad$

## Example:

LA Alpha has 27 members.
27 members divided by $10=2.7$.
LA Alpha chapter would round up to three (3) delegates.
**Do not count the Chapter President / President alternate in your delegate number above or the following positions: International Board member, Past State President, District Chairman, and State Committee Chairman.

## Example:

The LA Alpha Chapter has a total of 27 members. (3)
State Treasurer Agnes, Chapter President Marion, and Past State President Marie, They would have six (6) voting delegates - Agnes, Marion, Marie, and three chapter members.
If you hold 2 voting positions, you only have one vote.
